Gensler is a painter and installation artist involved in large-scale public art projects and co-founder of Gensler + Gutierrez. Currently he is Adjunct Professor of public art at RPI in Troy, NY and 2002-2006 Lecturer at University of Pennsylvania School of Design. He received his B.S. from Skidmore College and M.F.A from the University of Pennsylvania and studied art history at the University of Vienna, Austria. 1995-2000 he participated as Artist in Residence through the NEA Arts in Education Program (coordinator: Arkansas Arts Council). In 2001 he was awarded a Vermont Studio Center Full Fellowship. 1997- 99 he received the Arkansas Arts Council Assistance Fund Grant. Gensler has completed over 30 public mural projects nationally that include a project with the Philadelphia DHS (*Symbols of Change*) located at 2110 Market St. and a 27,000 square foot mural with the Eagles Youth Partnership (*Moving Toward Your Dreams*) across from Lincoln Financial Field in Philadelphia. His work has been exhibited nationally and internationally with organizations such as the Korean National University of the Arts, Seoul, Korea.
